Texture Variation

More Food, Fewer Calories

Another advantage of wet food is that it contains less than half the calories of dry food. In other words, wet food offers a larger portion size with fewer calories, compared to eating dry food alone. If you are trying to help manage your dog's weight, wet food could be a good solution.

Making the Switch to Wet Dog Food

If you're planning on transitioning your dog from a dry food diet to a mixed or wet food diet, remember that gradual change is best. Start by offering one wet meal a day and seeing how their appetite adapts.
